## Activity Guidelines

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### Make sure you:

- ✓ Use your violin, viola, cello, or bass
- ✓ Interact with your audience
- ✓ Do something away from your home
- ✓ Do something creative

### Do not:

- ✓ Play in public without adult supervision
- ✓ Take \$ or any reward for your actions
- ✓ Use Strolling gigs for this; this project is independent of Strolling Strings

This activity can be done individually or in a group. Each student is responsible for documenting his/her activity on his/her poster.

## Poster Guidelines

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Document your activity on a poster board (22" x 28"). Be sure to include the following:

1. **My activity.** Describe what happened at your activity.
  - a. Include *Who? What? Where? When? and Why?*
2. **My activity's outcome.** Describe your thoughts about the activity's outcome.
  - a. How successful was it? How did it make you feel?
3. **The effect on my audience.** Describe how your audience reacted.
  - a. If possible, have *them* write a brief description of how it made them feel and include this paper on your poster.
4. **Two quotes.** Somewhere on the poster, include two quotes about helping or giving to others.
  - a. **One** should be an existing quote that is meaningful to you. Ex: "*A life isn't significant except for its impact on others.*" ~Jackie Robinson
  - b. **The other** will be an original quote (about helping or giving), written by you.
5. **Presentation.** All information on your poster should be clear and easy to read. Feel free to add illustrations, music, and artwork!

## Grading will be based on:

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- ✓ Effort put forth in your "Giving Bach" activity
- ✓ Originality of your activity
- ✓ Information included on your poster (did you include everything asked for?)
- ✓ Clarity, neatness, and creativity of your poster
