2. To maintain the instrument regularly, according to its specific needs (clean, oil, grease, polish, etc.)
3. To pay for any loss or damage to the instrument, whether the instrument is at school or at home (outside of normal wear and tear use, as determined by the Music Director).
4. To surrender the BPS Music Instrument issued to me at any time, upon notice by a BPS Music Director.
5. All sticks and mallets will be included for percussion instruments.

MORE INFORMATION

The following instruments are issued as school equipment: piccolo, Eb clarinet, bass clarinet, tenor saxophone, baritone saxophone, bassoon, French horn, mellophone (horn), baritone, tuba, sousaphone, percussion, cello, and bass.

If at any time your school-owned instrument needs repair, or you are experiencing problems with it for whatever reason, contact the Music Directors immediately. As a result of normal use and wear, school-owned instruments will need regular maintenance and occasional repairs. Repairs are costly and time-consuming – please take good care of your instrument!

Instruments are generally issued in June, then collected (or reissued) at the end of the school year in May. During the last week of school, all school-owned instruments will be collected for inspection and/or routine scheduled maintenance. This rental applies to full or partial year use of Bismarck Public Schools equipment.
